A refund of ticket costs can only be made where either the ticket has not yet been purchased or the ticket is sold to another member. Refunds - All refunds will be made after the theatre event/outing has taken place Guest policy - Non-members can come on a theatre event/outing as a guest of a member on one occasion only.
