Walking in patients with normal pressure hydrocephalus and healthy older adults

Volunteers are needed for a research study comparing the walking gait of healthy control subjects with patients suffering from normal pressure hydrocephalus. Control subjects need to be >60 years old and free from injury or neurological disorder. Volunteers will be asked to go once to a gait laboratory at Manchester Metropolitan University, where they will complete some questionnaires and undertake a gait assessment. They will be given a Fitbit to record activity levels for 1 week.
